Year 6 Cooking Lesson 1 – Thursday 25th and Friday 26th April 2024

As part of our Design and Technology curriculum, children are taught about balanced diets, the effect of different food groups on the body and seasonal produce. Alongside this, children will also learn practical cooking skills such as choosing the correct equipment for a recipe, chopping skills, using the hob and the oven and kitchen health and safety.

To support this, children will be given the opportunity to produce two dishes – cheese scones and tomato pasta. Children will do this in school, and all ingredients will be provided. The first cooking session will begin on **Thursday 25th April 2024**, and we will be making cheese scones.
