SATs Information – W/C Monday 12th May 2025

As you will all know, SATs week is approaching. We would be grateful for your support with a few things. It is a very tiring week for the children, so please ensure that your child has plenty of rest and goes to bed at a sensible hour.

Please make sure that children arrive in school on time and that you have not booked any routine dental, doctors or other appointments during the mornings. We are offering the opportunity for children to enter school at **8.15am** to receive breakfast, supplied by the school, consisting of buttered toast, brioche/ chocolate chip brioche/ pain au chocolate and squash. This is intended to give the children an extra boost of energy alongside their usual morning routine, so please give your children their breakfast as normal before leaving home.
