Dear Parent / Carers

Plas Gwynant Residential – Monday 10th November 2025 – Friday 14th November 2025

As the trip to Plas Gwynant is almost upon us, and the excitement is mounting amongst the pupils (and staff), here are few items of essential information:

- Children should bring their suitcases into the main hall at normal school opening time on Monday 10th November 2025.
- The coach is expected to leave at around 9.30am.
- A packed lunch is required for the journey which the children will take on the coach. This should be in a separate bag and in a lunch box (the lunch box will be essential throughout the week). Children will not be allowed to eat or drink on the coach – but there will be a stop, half way through the journey.
- If your child requires travel-sickness medication, please come into the school office prior to the visit to complete a permission form, and then send the medication in a clearly labelled bag on the day of the trip.
- Unfortunately, we are unable to take any other medication **unless it has been prescribed**. If your child does have prescribed medication, please complete a care plan prior to the visit at the school office. This will need to be completed by **Friday 17th October 2025**.
- Please remember to check the Plas Gwynant kit list, and note that **Plas Gwynant will supply waterproof trousers and coat, a fleece, wellingtons, a ruck sack and a water bottle to every pupil**. One essential item that is often overlooked is a black bin-bag or two - these are life-savers if there are any wet clothes on the last day, and are great just for stuffing dirty laundry in to.
- **Electronic items should not be brought on the trip**. We do not want expensive gadgets to get lost or damaged. The Plas Gwynant kit list suggests an mp3 player as an option but please **do not** send one with your child. Abbey staff will organise primary-age appropriate music to be played in the games room at the centre. Also, there is literally no mobile phone signal at Plas Gwynant so please **do not** send children on the trip with mobile phones.
